



Artistree Community Gallery is pleased to offer a new opportunity to area artists to exhibit and sell their work in our S. Pomfret gallery. We will be accepting applications from individual artists and artist groups to have an exhibit installed in one, two, or all three rooms in our gallery, for a 4-week period, to be scheduled in 2022. Applications are limited to artists living & working in VT or NH>

Artists can apply separately, or as a group. If separately, we will endeavor to find others with complementary work to fill the gallery if necessary, and/or install your work as a "Featured Artist" during one of our group shows.

Submission guidelines are below. Both 2-D and 3-D artists can apply. Please submit your information through our website here - <https://artistreevt.org/apply-to-exhibit.html>. Work priced for sale should include 35% commission to Artistree.

- Artists(s) name and contact info (email, phone number, mailing address, website if applicable)
- A brief artist's bio and statement about your work.
- 4-6 images of artwork that are representative of the work you propose to exhibit. Files should be in jpg format and be labelled LastName_Title_year completed.
- Please keep a list for your reference to accompany your image files, including title, medium, artwork dimensions, and price.
- Specify the space you are applying for, based on the information below.

Our space has three rooms available for exhibition, with gallery lighting and pedestals available for 3-D work. The sizes and fees for each room are -

- Small Room - ~168 sq.ft, 7' ceiling height - \$75
- Medium Room - ~285 sq.ft, 8' ceiling, 2 windows - \$100
- Large Room - ~580 sq.ft, 9.5' ceiling, bay window, exit door - \$150

Artistree will install the exhibit and promote it on our website and other outlets, create flyers and a banner sign, and provide an opening reception for the public. Further promotions such as postcard mailings will be available at the artists' expense. We would also encourage and like to facilitate any artist talks, workshops, or demonstrations that the artists would like to hold during the course of their show. All work should be dry to the touch upon arrival, framed and ready for hanging/ installing. Artists will be responsible for delivering and picking up their work on agreed-upon dates.
